The routing service is based on the data provided by the Graphen Integrationsplattform (GIP), which is maintained by various bureaus of the Federal State of Tyrol and the individual communities. The online service by the Federal State of Tyrol considers itself to be a service portal for all Tyrolean residents, as well as any person wishing to find out more about the cycling options in the Federal State of Tyrol.
